Lois Ann Worley, 89, of Decatur, passed away on Thursday, October 10, 2019, at St. Mary's Hospital in Decatur.

Lois was born in West Allis, WI, on August 20, 1930, a daughter of Calvin Eugene Pynn and Marian Helen (Jones) Pynn. She married Leon Max Worley on June 24, 1950, in West Allis, WI.

Lois is survived by five sons: John (Linda) Worley of Decatur; Paul Worley of Urbandale, IA; Joseph (Mary) Worley of Canal Fulton, OH; David Worley of Fairfield Glade, TN; and James (Becky) Worley of Flower Mound, TX; two daughters: Susan Portwood of Corning, NY; and Nancy (Dan) Guenther of Glencoe, IL; thirteen grandchildren; and six great-grandchildren.
