Decatur – Florence Shaw Flenner, 97, of Decatur, IL, passed away Sunday, July 1, 2018, in her home surrounded by family.

Florence was born January 2, 1921, in Crawford County IL, the daughter of Frank L. and Bertha A. (Rains) Shaw. She was a homemaker and member of the Elwin United Methodist Church. Florence married William Arvine Flenner on November 17, 1940, in her childhood Universalist Church in Hutsonville, IL. They moved to Decatur in 1941 when Arvine accepted a job with Illinois Bell. Arvine preceded her in death on February 6, 1989. Also preceding her in death were her brothers: Richard, Edward, John, Carl and Robert.

Florence was a sixty year member of Macon County Home Extension. She enjoyed special tours to Europe with Barb's Travel Group; and her winters with her Grape Hammock family in Florida.
