**R**andy E. Morris, 59, of Decatur, passed away Friday, February 16, 2018 at St. John's Hospital in Springfield.

Randy was born September 14, 1958, in Decatur, Illinois, the son of Dallas and Phyllis (Thompson) Morris. He proudly served his country in the Army National Guard in Subic Bay, Philippines. Randy graduated from Sangamon State University (UIS) with BS in Political Science.
