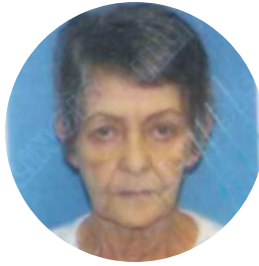

Decatur-Nancy S. Ogilvie, 74, of Decatur, passed away Sunday, May 8, 2016 in her home.

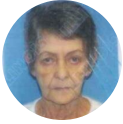
