Anthony Joseph Viccone II, 82, of Decatur, passed away Thursday, August 27, 2015 at Eastview Terrace in Sullivan.

Tony was born March 3, 1933 in New York, New York, the son of Anthony Joseph and Nona Alice (Gamble) Viccone Sr. He proudly served his country in the U.S. Army as a Corporal Signal Corp. with the 44th Infantry Division during the Korean War. He graduated from Stephen Decatur High School and Millikin University. Tony was previously employed as a field representative with the IL State Dept. of Employment retiring December 31, 1988 after thirty years of service.
