Decatur-Andrew Z. "Andy" "Homer" Mullins, 72, of Decatur, passed away Sunday, November 23, 2014 at Decatur Memorial Hospital with his family by his side.

Andy was born July 16, 1942 in Mingo County, West Virginia the son of Andrew J. and Elizabeth (Toler) Mullins. He was a former roofer with Bill High at R.L. High Construction.
