Decatur-Michael Edward Siburt, 63, of Decatur, passed away at 10:15 a.m. Sunday, September 2, 2012 in Carle Foundation Hospital in Urbana.

A memorial gathering will be held from 10-10:30 a.m. Saturday, September 8, 2012 at Crestview Worship Center, 4415 N. Water, Decatur. Michael was born September 8, 1948 in Decatur the son of William and Lou Ann (Wagner) Siburt. He graduated from Stephen Decatur High in 1966.
