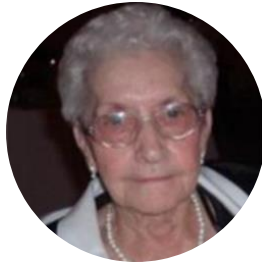

Beulah A. Dotson, 94, of Decatur, formerly of Anderson, IN, passed away Friday, June 22, 2012, in Decatur.

Beulah was born August 24, 1917 in Vandalia the daughter of Roy E. and Zelphia (Cox) Selby. She worked as a cook at Chesterfield and Highland High Schools.
