Mignon Moore Snyder, 75, of Vero Beach, Florida died at the VNA Hospice House Saturday night April 16th after a 12-year battle against cancer. Mignon was born in Decatur, Illinois October 18, 1935 to C. B. (Cloyd) and Audra (Bartlett) Moore, and was a graduate of Blue Mound High School, Blue Mound, IL. She had been active in a number of businesses throughout her life, including the operations of the family farm in Blue Mound.
