Decatur-Wilbur 'Buzz' Allen, 63 of Decatur, passed away 5:45 p.m. Thursday, October 7, 2010 at Mattoon Health Care and Rehabilitation Center, with his family by his side.

Services to celebrate Buzz's life will be 10 a.m. Monday, October 11, 2010 at Graceland/Fairlawn Funeral Home. Visitation will be from 5-7 p.m. Sunday, October 10, 2010 at the funeral home.
