## Robert Kenneth Ducey

**R**obert Kenneth Ducey, 70, of Decatur, IL, passed away February 8, 2020 at Decatur Memorial Hospital.

Robert was born November 11, 1949 in Decatur, IL, the son of Kenneth and Charlotte (Davis) Ducey. He was a veteran of the US Army, serving during the Vietnam era. Following his military service, he worked and retired from Firestone, serving as a Fork Truck driver. After his retirement he was employed by K's Merchandise as a furniture assembler and then D and D Integration. He married Linda Hupp on May 29, 1982 in Argenta, IL.

Robert was a member of the Moose Lodge and UAW local 751. He was an avid antique collector and enjoyed going to rummage sales. He had a quick wit and enjoyed making others laugh.

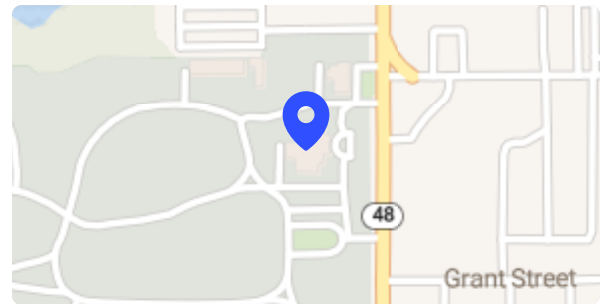

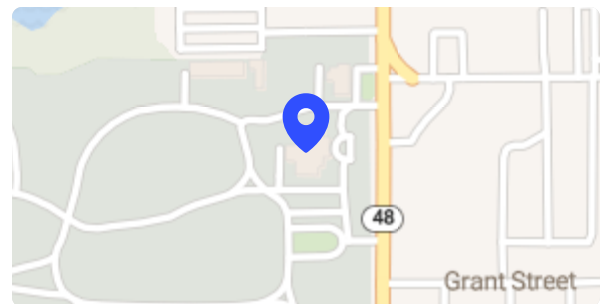

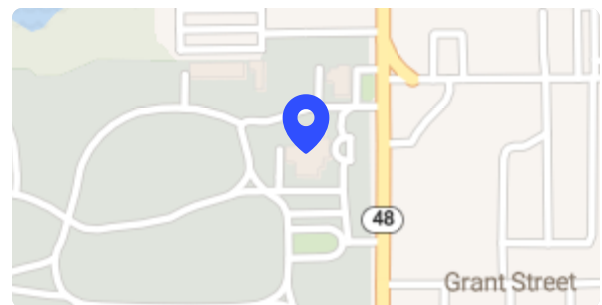
