Ida Mae (Nichols) Sutton, 90, of Decatur, passed away Wednesday, July 19, 2023, at her home, surrounded by her family.

A service to celebrate the life of Ida Mae will be held at 11:00am Tuesday, July 25, 2023, at Graceland Fairlawn Funeral Home with visitation Monday, July 24, 2023, from 6:00pm to 8:00pm at the funeral home.
