Pauline Conyer, 86, of Decatur Il passed away on June 19, 2024 at Lewis Memorial Christian Village. She was born January 18, 1938 on Monticello KY to Obie and Mary Abbott.

Pauline graduated from Woodruff High School in Peoria, IL. Later in life, she returned to school and completed an associate's degree from Richland Community College and a Bachelor of Arts degree from Eastern Illinois University. She was a member of Riverside Baptist Church in Decatur, IL. She was also a long-time volunteer with the Macon County Conservation District. She loved working with her hands, including gardening, quilting, and designing floral arrangements.

Pauline loved her family deeply. She helped start the Abbott-Vaughn family reunion in Turkey Run, IN. and also frequently attended the Abbott reunion in her birthplace of Monticello, KY. She did extensive research into her family ancestry, which culminated in her writing a manuscript of her family's life in the hills of Kentucky called Through My Eyes in 1997.
