Decatur – William Lee “Bill” Morgan, 90, of Forsyth, passed away Friday, January 17, 2025, at Decatur Memorial Hospital.

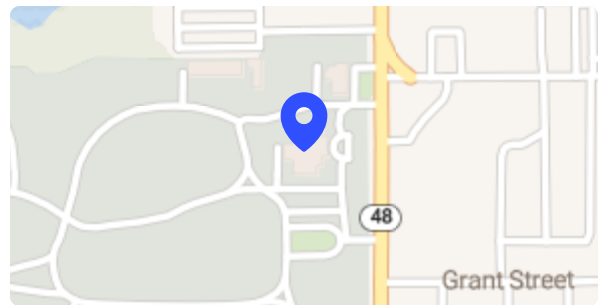

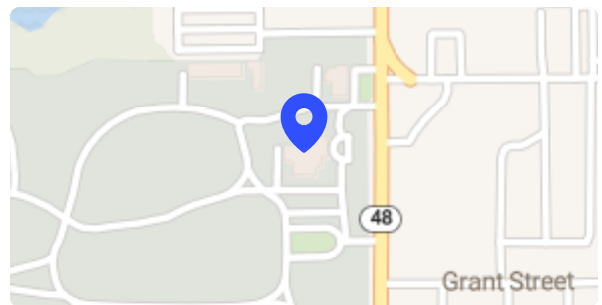
