Dave was born on August 19, 1951, in Decatur, IL, the son of Donald William Sapp and Wilma Joan (Wyant) Sapp. He married Karyn Leigh Wilson on October 4, 1974, in Decatur, IL.

Dave served his country in the United States Air Force during Vietnam. He served as County Board Chairman, was the County Auditor for several years and a very strong Democrat. Dave was a big history buff, especially about the Civil War. 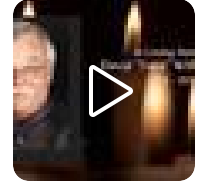

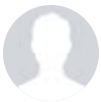
