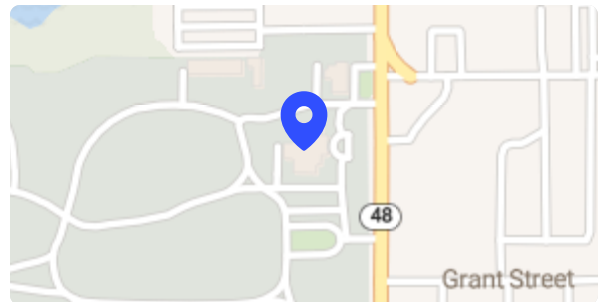

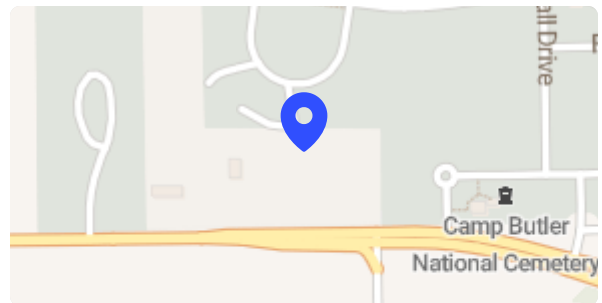

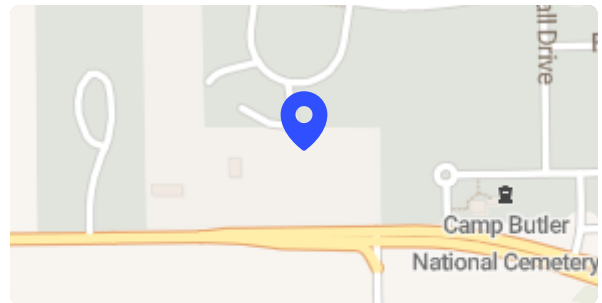

I remember when I and my kids spent a lot of time at kenney n his family's home.we had some great times.

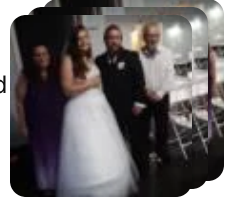
